



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and executed on this 10th January, 2020 between CSIR-Central Road Research Institute, Mathura Road, New Delhi-110025 which is a constituent establishment of the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, a Society registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 and having its registered office at Anusandhan Bhawan, 2, Rafi Marg Delhi-110001 hereinafter referred to as CSIR-CRRI through its authorized representative, the Director, CSIR-CRRI.

And

Madhya Pradesh Rural Connectivity Training and Research Centre (MPRCTRC), Bhopal renamed as Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Academy (MPRRA). MPRCTRC is an organization under Panchayat and Rural Development Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh, with its office located on the right bank of Kaliasot Dam in Walmi Hills on Kolar Road, Bhopal. The MPRCTRC is aiming to develop as Centre of Excellence in Training and Research in Rural Roads through capacity building and human resources development in the state. The state has been successful in building capacities of different stakeholders such as Govt. Professionals, policy makers on issues related to Rural Road Construction, Maintenance and Road Safety.

Preamble

The CSIR-CRRI, a premier national laboratory established in 1952, a constituent of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) has expertise and capabilities for conducting research, development activities and carrying out consultancy assignments including dissemination of knowledge through training etc. in the areas of roads, bridges, traffic and transportation, ground improvement and geotechnical engineering, rural roads, pavement design, pavement performance and its evaluation, Asset Management, maintenance practices instrumentation, environment and road safety.

Whereas, CSIR-CRRI and MPRCTRC, now agreed upon to work collaboratively with the following purpose and objectives and the given broad terms and conditions.

In the spirit of intellectual cooperation scholarly exchange, and the development of national partnership with leading institutions, MPRCTRC and the CSIR-CRRI agree to establish a program of exchange and collaboration on related matters of mutual interest that may emerge over time.

Areas of Mutual Interest

1. The purposes of the cooperation are to promote cooperative research and to facilitate the exchange of ideas, the development of new knowledge, and to enhance high quality research acumen. The major thrust of the activities on which the parties will cooperate are rural connectivity and skill development. The modes of cooperation will include:
 - a. Exchanges of faculty and students for the purposes of research and teaching;
 - b. The development and implementation of professional development programs, and capacity-building efforts;
 - c. The dissemination of findings through scholarly publications, white papers, and in the media;
2. To achieve the goals of this cooperation, both parties will, insofar as the means of each allow: a) organize symposia, conferences, and meetings on timely research issues; b) develop and carry out joint research programs; and c) exchange information pertaining to the agreed-upon research areas.
3. Prior to the initiation of any particular project or activity, the specific terms of cooperation and exchange for that project will be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate responsible representatives of both institutions.
4. Both parties understand that all financial arrangements for specific exchange activities must be mutually agreed upon and will depend on the availability of funds. In addition, the scope of the activities will be subject to funds available at the institutions for the type of collaboration undertaken and any financial assistance that may be obtained by either from external sources.
5. Research of locally available including marginal materials. Performance evaluation of use of new materials and techniques.

Sharing of costs

Either party may propose to the other specific individual research projects for collaboration. Such proposal may be made at any time and the parties will develop an agreement for each agreed-upon project. The protection and exploitation of any intellectual property arising out of a research project will be addressed in each individual project agreement early on and ongoing.

Miscellaneous

1. Each institution agrees to release and hold the other harmless from and against any claims, damages, liability or costs, to the extent such claims damages, liability or costs arise from the negligent or willful acts or omission of the other university/institutes or any of its agents or employees in connection with their respective performance under this MoU.
2. The parties agree that in the course of implementing this MoU, they will not engage in unlawful discrimination on the grounds of race, gender,

sexual orientation, age, religion, social class, national or ethnic origin or disability.

3. Amendments to this MoU may be made at any time after consultation and agreement between the two institutions. Any such amendment must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Validity of MoU

1. This MoU will remain in force for a period of three years from the date it is fully executed. The MoU can also be suitably modified, as agreed to by both the parties, to reflect an increased scope, nature of engagement/activities including financial commitments, if any. Prior to the expiration date, the MoU may be reviewed for possible renewal for a further three-year period. In addition, either party may terminate the MoU in advance of its normal expiration by providing the other with six months prior written notice. In this case, persons already approved as exchange participants will be allowed to complete their exchange visits under the conditions specified at the time of their invitation to the host institution.

Confidentiality

1. Each party agrees that it will not, either during or after expire or termination of this MoU, make any unauthorized use or disclosure of any confidential information disclosed to it by the other party pursuant to this MoU.
2. Both CSIR-CRRI and MPRCTRC shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third parties without written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this MoU. (Article 3)

Disputes

Any dispute or difference arising under or in relation to this MoU shall be referred to the Arbitrators. If resolution is not possible then the unresolved

dispute will be referred jointly to Director CRR I and Director, MPRCTRC.
